





Factors contributing to participant satisfaction (very and extremely satisfied %)

Participants are most satisfied with the friendliness and safety of the club environment, as well as the encouragement of fair play. However, the lowest levels of satisfaction were related to officials, the fairness of opportunities, and facilities. NB: This pattern has been consistent in Voice of Participant results over previous years.



The club environment (% agree and strongly agree)


